The Institutional Ethical Committee (IEC) was formed in 2016.

Functions of IEC

- To maintain a consistent scientific and ethical framework for patient care and research, and for integrating ethical values into practice, policy relationships, and organizational activities.
- To review and approve proposals for clinical and laboratory research for scientific and ethical content.
- To improve ethical standards and issue guidelines on ethical dilemmas related to patient care services.
- To ensure clinical research projects that will safe guard patients well being and maintain social integrity with respect to research at its top most priority.
- To work as a forum to advise the administration in case of any ethical issues that may arise from patients, families or public in general.









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Function of Institutional Ethics Committee

- IEC will review and approve all type of research proposals involving human participants with view to safeguard the dignity, right, safety, and well being of all actual and potential research participants.
- The IEC will take care that all the cardinal principal of research ethics viz. Autonomy, Beneficence, non-maleficence and justice are taken care of in planning, conduct and reporting of the proposed research.
- 3. It will review the proposal before start of the study as well as monitor the research throughout the study until and after completion of the study through appropriate well documented procedure for example annual reports, final reports and site visit etc.
- The committee will also examine compliance with all regulatory requirements, applicable guidelines and laws.
- The IEc will review all research project involving human subject to be conducted at the institute, irrespective of the function agency.









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INSTITUTIONAL ETHICS COMMITTEE (IEC)

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. All proposals should be submitted in hard & soft copy form (through google form link), copies of which will be available with the Member Secretary.
- 2. All relevant documents should be enclosed with application. (Example- Annexures, Questionnaires, Consent form, etc.)
- 3. The required number of copies of the proposal along with the application and documents in prescribed format duly signed by the main and Co-investigators/Collaborators should be submitted.
- 4. The Member Secretary will acknowledge the receipt and indicate any missing information in IEC Meeting. Inadequate information should be supplied within one week.
- 5. The date of meeting will be intimated to the primary investigator who should be available to offer clarifications if necessary. (Meetings will take place weekly on Saturday)
- 6. The decision of IEC will be communicated in writing. If revision is to be made, the revised document in required number of copies should be submitted within a stipulated period of time as specified in the communication (Within one week).

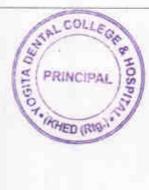
