



### CODE OF ETHICS

The Institutional Ethical Committee (IEC) was formed in 2016.

IEC is registered under Rule no 17 of the New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019 the designated authority in the Department of Health Research, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India.

#### **Objectives of IEC**

1. To promote a democratic exchange of scientific and ethical values dealing to critically analyzing them and providing sustainable opportunities to budding researchers to enhance scientific and ethical integrity within the institution.
2. To ensure competent review and appraisal of all scientific and ethical aspects of research projects received in accordance to International Council of Harmonization and Good Clinical Practices, 1996.
3. To ensure that objective of the research work is well defined, free from bias in design methodology, data analysis and data interpretation.
4. To promote research topics which will be relevant with current global scenario leading to overall welfare of the society, community, nation and the nature.

#### **Functions of IEC**

1. To maintain highest level of scientific and ethical standards of research at YDCH, Khed
2. To maintain a consistent scientific and ethical framework for patient care and research, and for integrating ethical values into practice, policy relationships, and organizational activities.
3. To review and approve proposals for clinical and laboratory research for scientific and ethical content.
4. To improve ethical standards and issue guidelines on ethical dilemmas related to patient care services.
5. To ensure clinical research projects that will safe guard patients well being and maintain social integrity with respect to research at its top most priority.
6. To work as a forum to advise the administration in case of any ethical issues that may arise from patients, families or public in general.



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**Function of Institutional Ethics Committee**

1. IEC will review and approve all type of research proposals involving human participants with view to safeguard the dignity, right, safety, and well being of all actual and potential research participants.
2. The IEC will take care that all the cardinal principal of research ethics viz. Autonomy, Beneficence, non-maleficence and justice are taken care of in planning, conduct and reporting of the proposed research.
3. It will review the proposal before start of the study as well as monitor the research throughout the study until and after completion of the study through appropriate well documented procedure for example annual reports, final reports and site visit etc.
4. The committee will also examine compliance with all regulatory requirements, applicable guidelines and laws.
5. The IEc will review all research project involving human subject to be conducted at the institute, irrespective of the function agency.

## Reporting of background should include

- Problem definition
- Hypothesis statement
- Description of study outcome(s)
- Type of exposure or intervention used
- Type of study designs used
- Study population

## Reporting of search strategy should include

- Qualifications of searchers (eg, librarians and investigators)
- Search strategy, including time period included in the synthesis and keywords
- Effort to include all available studies, including contact with authors
- Databases and registries searched
- Search software used, name and version, including special features used (eg, explosion)
- Use of hand searching (eg, reference lists of obtained articles)
- List of citations located and those excluded, including justification
- Method of addressing articles published in languages other than English
- Method of handling abstracts and unpublished studies
- Description of any contact with authors

## Reporting of methods should include

- Description of relevance or appropriateness of studies assembled for assessing the hypothesis to be tested
- Rationale for the selection and coding of data (eg, sound clinical principles or convenience)
- Documentation of how data were classified and coded (eg, multiple raters, blinding, and interrater reliability)
- Assessment of confounding (eg, comparability of cases and controls in studies where appropriate)
- Assessment of study quality, including blinding of quality assessors; stratification or regression on possible predictors of study results
- Assessment of heterogeneity
- Description of statistical methods (eg, complete description of fixed or random effects models, justification of whether the chosen models account for predictors of study results, dose-response models, or cumulative meta-analysis) in sufficient detail to be replicated
- Provision of appropriate tables and graphics

## Reporting of results should include

- Graphic summarizing individual study estimates and overall estimate
- Table giving descriptive information for each study included
- Results of sensitivity testing (eg, subgroup analysis)
- Indication of statistical uncertainty of findings

## Reporting of discussion should include

- Quantitative assessment of bias (eg, publication bias)
- Justification for exclusion (eg, exclusion of non-English-language citations)
- Assessment of quality of included studies

## Reporting of conclusions should include

- Consideration of alternative explanations for observed results
- Generalization of the conclusions (ie, appropriate for the data presented and within the domain of the literature review)
- Guidelines for future research
- Disclosure of funding source
