Follow up reports

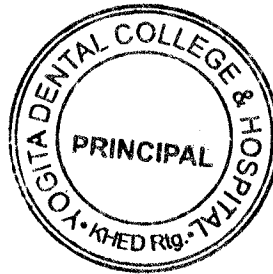

- Mess menu was discussed with the canteen committee and revised menu was framed.

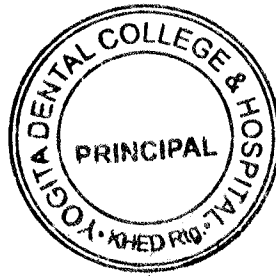

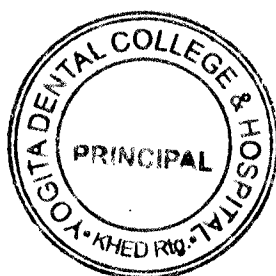

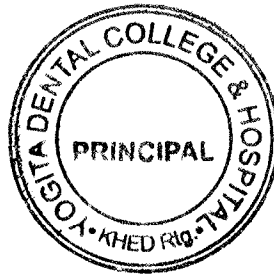
- No issues were reported by parents and students. All the students have satisfactory performances in their studies.

Issues raised by students

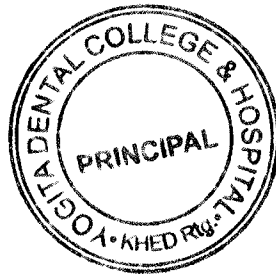
- PG students from department of prosthodontics were reported with issue of working of suction in some of dental chairs.
