lifestyle choices. The harmful impact of second-hand smoke was explained especially to the family members of smokers along with the impactful role of family in quitting the habit.

The locals with habit of *Mishri chewing* – roasted tobacco (Smokeless form of Tobacco) was targeted with the individual counselling and pamphlets in local language (Marathi) were distributed for daily reinforcements. Also, free toothpastes were distributed to the locals to inculcate the habit of using toothpaste for brushing instead of *Mishri*. They were also informed about the availability and utilization of TCC centre in the institute and free counselling services available in the institute.





B) Preventive Activities:

Educational workshop:

CDE Webinar was organized on occasion of World No Tobacco Day on 31/05/2024. Subject of the webinar was- Protecting children from tobacco industry interference. It was delivered by Dr. Akshatha Gadiyar (Assistant Professor in Dept of Public Health Dentistry at Goa Dental College & Hospital, Bambolim, Goa). The webinar was conducted via Google meet platform. Students from 3rd year & 4th year, as well as interns participated enthusiastically. It was as engaging and informative session focusing mainly on how the young generation is attracted to the tobacco industry. MSDC approved 3 CDE points (MSDC/CDE/319/2024-2025) were awarded to all the participants.





C) Screening Outreach Activities:

- Free Oral Health Screenings: The college organized 3 free oral health screening camps offering comprehensive dental examinations to community members dated 16/05/2024, 27/05/2024 and 05/06/2024 in the local college Special emphasis was placed on detecting early signs of tobacco-related oral diseases such as oral cancer, periodontal disease, and leukoplakia.
- Referral Services: Participants identified with suspicious oral lesions or tobacco-related oral health issues were provided with referrals to specialized healthcare facilities for further evaluation and treatment.



2. IEC Activities:

A) Information Dissemination:

 Brochures and Pamphlets: The college produced and distributed informative brochures and pamphlets detailing the adverse effects of tobacco on oral health, emphasizing statistics, facts, and cessation resources at Khed Bus stand on 31/05/2024.






Posters and Banners:


B) Competitions organized:

T-shirt Painting Competition: Theme: Awareness about ill effects of Tobacco

In order to create awareness on III effects of Tobacco Consumption among students as well as patient's T-shirt painting competition was organized. Students from 1st, 2nd, 3rd and final year. Interns and post graduate students also participated in the competition.



• IEC material designing competition and LOGO designing competition: Impactful and effective IEC material plays an important role during patient education and oral health promotion. In order to achieve that a competition was organized by Dept of Public health Dentistry. Students (Undergraduates, Interns and postgraduates participated in the competition. All the students participated enthusiastically and showed great amount of creativity. Prizes were distributed on World No Tobacco Day (31/05/2024)



3. Oral Cancer Screening Activities:

Oral Cancer Screening Camp at Bus stand, Khed

- Dept. of Public Health Dentistry organized Free Oral Cancer Screening Camp in collaboration with Dept. of Oral Pathology at Bus stand of Khed on 31/05/2024, for the locals and patients coming from outside of Khed were targeted.
- Students from **YDCH NSS Unit** (2nd, 3rd, 4th year and interns) took part in the camp to assist interns for Oral cancer screening test Toluidine blue stain.
- Screening Procedure: <u>Toluidine Blue Test</u>: The interns trained by the Dept of Oral Pathology administered the Toluidine Blue Test, a dye-based staining technique used to identify suspicious areas in the oral cavity. Toluidine blue selectively stains areas of tissue that have increased metabolic activity, which can indicate early stages of oral cancer or precancerous lesions. Around 57 patients were screened for oral cancer.
- Clinical Examination: Concurrently, participants underwent comprehensive oral examinations conducted by the students to assess overall oral health status, identify abnormalities, and provide immediate referrals for further evaluation if necessary. One to one counselling and Oral Health Awareness talks were delivered by the students at the Khed Bus stand.

4. Training and Capacity Building Programs

Program Components:

1. Educational training was conducted for Interns during their TCC posting:

- o Basic Concepts of Tobacco Control: Introductory lectures were conducted to familiarize participants with the basic concepts of tobacco control, including the global and local prevalence of tobacco use, its health impacts, and the socio-economic consequences
- Policy and Advocacy Training: Sessions were held to educate students on tobacco control policies, advocacy strategies, and the importance of community mobilization in fostering a supportive environment for tobacco-free living.

2. Skills Development:

- Behavioural Interventions: Practical training sessions focused on behavioural interventions for tobacco cessation, equipping participants with counselling techniques, motivational interviewing skills, and strategies to support individuals in quitting tobacco.
- Communication and Campaign Planning: Workshops were conducted to enhance participants' abilities in designing effective communication campaigns, crafting compelling messages, and engaging diverse audiences in anti-tobacco advocacy.

3. Resource Mobilization:

- Networking and Partnership Building: Participants were encouraged to forge partnerships with local stakeholders, healthcare providers, educational institutions, and community organizations to leverage resources, share best practices, and amplify the impact of anti-tobacco initiatives conducted by the TCC.
- Grant Writing and Fundraising: Capacity-building sessions were conducted to guide participants in grant writing, fundraising strategies, and sustainability planning to secure financial support for ongoing tobacco control programs and activities.

4. Monitoring and Evaluation:

o **Impact Assessment:** Training modules also included sessions on monitoring and evaluating anti-tobacco initiatives, measuring program outcomes, and using data-driven approaches to assess the effectiveness of interventions and inform continuous improvement.

Outcome:

The Training and Capacity Building Program for Anti-Tobacco Initiatives facilitated by the Institute in the Kokan region yielded significant outcomes mainly contributing around 87 trained dental health professionals who were empowered to practice Tobacco cessation counselling. Participants acquired comprehensive knowledge, practical skills, and strategic insights essential for implementing evidence-based tobacco control strategies. By fostering a community of empowered dentists and equipping them with the necessary tools to drive change, the program strengthened the foundation for sustained efforts in reducing tobacco use, promoting healthier lifestyles, and safeguarding oral health in the Kokan region. The collaborative efforts of participants, faculty members, healthcare professionals, and community partners underscored a collective commitment towards achieving tobacco-free environments, improving public health outcomes and increasing the number of patients (currently – 44) who have successfully quit the tobacco habits.

5. School based Tobacco Control and cessation initiatives:

School based outreach programs were conducted during the WNTD celebration week. The initiative has the following planned activities:


Prevention Strategies:

- Education and Awareness: During the Screening camps, an awareness seminar was organized
 that informed students about the dangers of tobacco use, focusing on its impact on health,
 academic performance, and social aspects. One to one counselling to students who are practicing
 the tobacco and tobacco products usage was conducted.
- 2. **Policy Development**: School administration was involved to implement or strengthen tobacco-free policies on campus, including no sellers within or around the campus and following the tobacco free environment at work by the working staff as well.
- 3. Peer Education & Teacher training: Training the teachers and appointing the student monitors to deliver anti-tobacco messages and support their peers in making healthy choices. Train teachers and relevant staff members on tobacco control strategies and how to support students in quitting tobacco use.

Cessation Support:

- 1. **Counseling Services**: Students were informed about the counselling services for students who want to quit smoking or using tobacco products under the parental involvement
- 2. **Behavioural Interventions**: Behavioural interventions and motivational interviewing techniques to help students overcome tobacco addiction and develop healthier habits was implemented during the screening visits.

Monitoring and Evaluation: Regularly monitoring the progress of the initiative, collecting data on tobacco use prevalence and student feedback was taken in order to make necessary adjustments.






